Lent : The initial response to the Lent Project, Toilet Twinning, in last week's Grapevine has been well received, and so we need to gather our thoughts together in order to be ready for Lent. It is a project whereby we raise money to provide basic toilets and training on hygiene in parts of the world where these facilities are not available.

There are so many reasons why the provision of basic toilet facilities improves the life of women and children, and for the cost of £60 we can provide one facility. I wonder how many toilets we could provide if we worked together?

You can do whatever you like... a coffee morning is always very popular. You could do something very personal: add something to a collecting pot each day: someone said, 5p every time you visited the bathroom. If you enjoy baking... a small cake sale after church. If you like preserves..., making jam and marmalade.

Think in terms of raising enough for one toilet... £60. If that sounds a little too adventurous, think in terms of half or even a quarter.

All those smaller amounts will add up.

The purpose of this project is to make a difference in the lives of others, but for us, we can treat it as a joyful response to living with clean water and good sanitation.


